Dear Parents,

As you may be aware, Twin Falls County has moved into an Orange Risk Level due to COVID-19. Because of this, Twin Falls School District is also moving into the orange modified school schedule. Please take a minute to read this letter as a reminder of what the Club's plan is regarding the different school district color designations.

We will be following along with what the Twin Falls School District does and will have our own set plans depending on what color the district is in at any given time. Below is a breakdown of how the Club will operate based on what color the Twin Falls School District is in:

**Green or Yellow:**

- Knetic & Club U hours and fees will remain the same
- No half-day programming will be provided with the exception of Knetic
- Face masks will be required on all school buses and Club vehicles. Parents are encouraged to provide their child with a face mask, but they will also be available to any child that does not have one
- Each child will have their temperature taken when they arrive off the bus and will receive hand sanitizer prior to entering the building
- Snack will be served in each Club U program area to eliminate all of the kids congregating together during snack time
- We will be limiting the number of parents in our lobby to 5 at a time
- The front desk staff will sign Club members in and out on the attendance sheets
- ALL staff, volunteers, parents, and any other adult will be asked to wear a face mask while in the building

**Orange or Red:**

- The Club will be open all day (6:45am-6:30pm) for any child that is scheduled to do at-home learning
- The Club will provide time and space for children to work on school work
- The monthly Knetic fee will remain the same
- If the district is in red for 10 or more days in a month, the Club U monthly fee will be eliminated and there will instead be a daily rate of \$8/day
- If you choose to utilize the Club for Club Days in an Orange schedule, there will be a daily rate of \$8. You will not be asked to pay the Club U monthly fee
- If you choose to only utilize the Club for afterschool (Orange only) and not Club Days, our Club U monthly fee will be adjusted to \$25
- Regularly scheduled Club Days will be changed to \$8 a day instead of the original \$12.
- *Face masks will be required on all school buses and Club vehicles, as well as inside the building at all times*
- Each child will have their temperature taken when they arrive off the bus and will receive hand sanitizer prior to entering the building
