# Let's Get Started: Important Summer Information!

**PLEASE READ!**

Dear Parents of Boys & Girls Club Members,

Summer is almost here, which means it's already time to get your child signed up for summer camps! Inside this BluePrint which is also located on our Bgcmv.com webpage underneath the Twin Falls Club tab, you'll find important information regarding all things summer – including a listing of all of our summer camps – complete with descriptions, costs, and age limits.

*Enrollment for summer camps for current/returning parents only will officially open online on **March 25, 2024**, on our Boys & Girls Club KidTrax website! If you have any issues getting to our website, please call 208-736-7011 ext 108.*

*\*A current/returning parent is defined as anyone who has a Trax account currently set up, and who has attended a parent orientation in the past.*

Our summer camps will begin Monday, June 3rd, and will run until Friday, August 9th. **(The Club will be closed May 27th-May 31st for Staff Training). The Club Will also be closed on July 4th and 5th for Independence Day.**

We are offering over 35 different camps this year, which will again run in two sessions: a morning session beginning at 9:00 a.m. and an afternoon session beginning at 1:00 p.m. each day. Each camp will run for one week. You can sign-up for an AM session, a PM session, or both... whatever works for the needs of your child(ren). Please note that if your child is at the Club during camp times, they **MUST** be enrolled in a camp.

**If your child arrives and is not already signed up, we will place them in a camp based on space availability and they will be required to stay there the remainder of the week, and you will be charged the camp fee.**

Each camp has a limited capacity of children. Once camps reach their capacity, they will close. So get them signed up early!

We are not requiring new/returning parents to attend orientation this year. If you have any questions or would like to request a refresher orientation, please email Jake Brasil at [jakebrasil@bgcmv.com](mailto:jakebrasil@bgcmv.com).

On April 29th, our team will review our capacities and begin calling new parents off of the digital waitlist. \*Reminder, we start a new waitlist every year.\* New parents will be able to begin enrolling their children after they have attended parent orientation. The dates for those orientations are subject to change but will likely occur on May 6 and 7th. You will be contacted and given that information.

### **To enroll your child in summer camps:**

Access our website by visiting [www.bgcmv.com](http://www.bgcmv.com), click “Our Clubs” and select the “Twin Falls Club.” click “Log in Here” **If you have already previously completed the online membership form & registration process for one of your children in the past:** Please do not complete it again; instead, please login to your family account by using the email address and password that you previously created.

Make sure that your child’s annual \$20 BGC membership is up-to-date and paid.

Make sure to pay the mandatory one-time \$60 Summer Activity Fee for each child. The purpose of the activity fee is to cover the cost of fuel for all of the field trips taken throughout the summer and sunscreen for all of our Club members for the entire summer. You can pay this fee by navigating to the Program Directory and adding “Summer 2024 Activity Fee” to your shopping cart.

Choose & pay for your child’s summer camps. Visit the Program Directory, where you can click on the appropriate summer camp and follow directions to add the camp to your shopping cart & check out – thus enrolling your child in that camp. **(We have no waiting lists for our summer camps, so if a camp is full, please choose one that is available.)**

At the end of the school year, Parents who have an outstanding balance from the 2023-2024 afterschool program will be notified that they will not be able to attend Summer 2024 until that balance is paid.

**IMPORTANT:** Signing up and **PAYING ONLINE** is the **ONLY** way to reserve your child’s spot in a camp! Thank you for the privilege of being a part of your child’s life! We are so excited to have a fun & successful summer at the Boys & Girls Club of Magic Valley!

## **Activ8 (10&11 Year Olds) & Elev8 (12&Up)**

### **Jr. Leaders Information**

The Boys & Girls Club Jr. Leaders Program is a voluntary mentoring and leadership training experience for Club members ages 13-16. It is a wonderful opportunity for our teenage Club members to take on responsibility and learn the crucial skills required to one day become a Club staff member! If interested in becoming a Jr. Leader, Club members must first meet certain requirements:

\*Be 13-16 years of age before June 3, 2024

\*Have a paid and current \$20 annual Boys & Girls Club membership

\*Complete and turn in a Jr. Leader application on our website [Bgcmv.com](http://Bgcmv.com) > Our Clubs > Twin Falls Club > Jr. Leader application

\*Complete all mandatory Jr. Staff trainings prior to the beginning of the summer

\*Attend Jr. Leader meetings/trainings

If a Club member meets all the requirements listed above and is hired as a Jr. Leader for the summer, they will be able to attend the Club for a 50% discount. However, if a Club member fails to successfully fulfill the duties of the Jr. Leader program with mentoring, training and encouragement from staff, they will be asked to pay for and attend the fee-based Activ8/Elev8 summer programs as a Club member instead.

If your child is 13 or older and will attend the Club during the summer, they MUST either be participating as a Jr. Leader member or enrolled in paid Activ8/Elev8 camps.
